

# **Youth Worker**

JOB DESCRIPTION

### Purpose of Job:

 The post holder will work as a Youth Worker for services in line with expected standards, policies and procedures.

### **Summary of Duties:**

- To work with young people to encourage their personal and social development. This will be achieved through face to face work with young people, individually or in groups;
- To ensure that all relevant policies and procedures are adhered to and that all co-workers are appraised of them. Liaise with the Youth Leader on any issues of health and safety or misconduct and ensure that immediate action is taken if there is a child protection issue;
- To contribute to the planning and preparation of activities;
- To supervise and contribute to the overall organisation of the 'Youth Space' to give an uncluttered but welcoming appearance;
- To ensure that young people have adequate refreshments/water available;
- To assist with clearing up 15 minutes before the end of each session (if appropriate), encouraging the young people to help;
- To ensure effective and accessible communication with staff, users, the general public and others as appropriate;
- To undertake any other duties commensurate with the post.

- Previous experience of work with young people;
- Commitment to providing excellent services;
- Ability to work effectively with a range of young people;
- An understanding of the issues affecting young people in today's society;
- A commitment to equalities issues, and ability to address them with young people;
- Knowledge of how young people can contribute to decision-making processes;
- Good interpersonal skills;
- Ability to follow instructions and work within management guidelines;
- Resourceful, imaginative and interested in young people's activities and development;
- A willingness to undertake relevant training when available;
- Child Protection and safeguarding aware.

## Desirable Skills/Knowledge/Abilities

- Conducting risk assessments in a youth work setting;
- First Aid qualification;
- Experience of working in a team;
- Experience of detached work with young people;
- Computer literate.
